RE: IMPORTANT NOTICE OF LEDGEMOOR BLVD / MORTON ROAD / OLD POST ROAD / MCDIARMID LANE **FINAL PAVING**

On **Monday, Oct. 23, 2017** the street paving process is tentatively scheduled to be completed in the areas indicated on the map. During the paving process **on Oct. 23, the noted sections will be closed to ALL traffic. Residents in the noted sections above will not have access to their driveways.** Should there be inclement weather, paving will be scheduled for **Tuesday, Oct. 24, 2017**. Please see information below for critical details regarding paving day.

How do I arrive at my home during the paving process?

Residents needing to access their homes between 8:00am – 4:00pm on Oct. 23 will need to park on the adjacent streets and walk to their home.

How do I leave my home during the paving process?

During paving, residents will NOT have access to the noted sections between 8:00am – 4:00pm. Please plan ahead and move your vehicle to one of the adjacent streets *before* 8:00am on Monday, Oct. 23. Any vehicle on your property after 8:00am on Oct. 23 cannot be moved until 4:00pm that afternoon, or when paving is complete and traffic is allowed on the road. On-street, overnight parking will be permitted on adjacent streets during the construction period.

Why is the schedule ‘tentative’?

Weather conditions, especially rain, can impact the start and/or completion of a street resurfacing project. The City will provide updates via www.cityofgrandledge.com and residents can also call the Public Services Department, Monday – Friday between 8:00am – 5:00pm at 517-627-2149.
