RE: IMPORTANT NOTICE OF ONEIDA WOODS TRAIL SEWER REPAIR

On **Thursday, Oct. 26, 2017** the City of Grand Ledge will be repairing the sanitary sewer line below Oneida Woods Trail at the indicated point on the map below.

Residents north of the repair site (in the noted section below) will not have access to their homes during repair, tentatively from 8:00 am – 5:00 pm.

During this repair, crews will be cutting the pavement and excavating down to the sanitary sewer line. The repair site will span the entire width of the road.

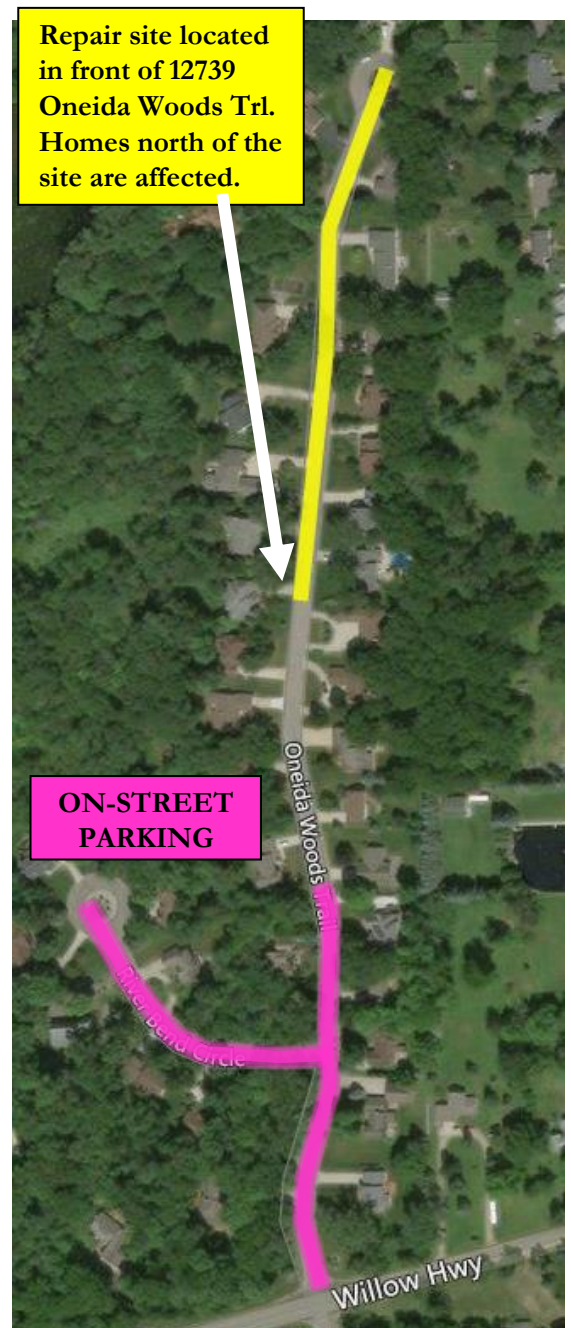
How do I access my home during the improvement project?

Residents north of the repair site will not have access to their homes during the repair. We are asking that all residents needing to leave their homes, move their vehicles prior to 8:00 am on Thursday, Oct. 26, 2017. Residents may park on-street south of the repair site on Oneida Woods Trail or River Bend Circle. As a safety precaution residents should park their vehicles a minimum of 100 ft. south of the repair site.

- *We recognize that Thursdays are Granger trash service pick-up days. Homes north of the repair site should relocate their trash bins to the curb at the intersection of River Bend Circle and Oneida Woods Trail. Alternately residents can choose not to place their trash bins out. It may be helpful to label your trash bin with your address using tape and a marker. Granger has been notified of the repair project. We apologize for this inconvenience to residents and thank you for your patience during this repair project.*

My home is not north of the repair site, what can I expect?

If your home is not north of the repair site in the indicated section, access to your home during repair will not be affected. Residents can expect increased on-street parking from neighbors living north of the repair site, as well as increased traffic on Thursday, Oct. 26, 2017, due to construction crews working to excavate the site and repair the sanitary sewer line.



Why is the schedule 'tentative'?

Weather conditions, especially rain, can impact the start and/or completion of a street resurfacing project. How will this affect bus stops?
