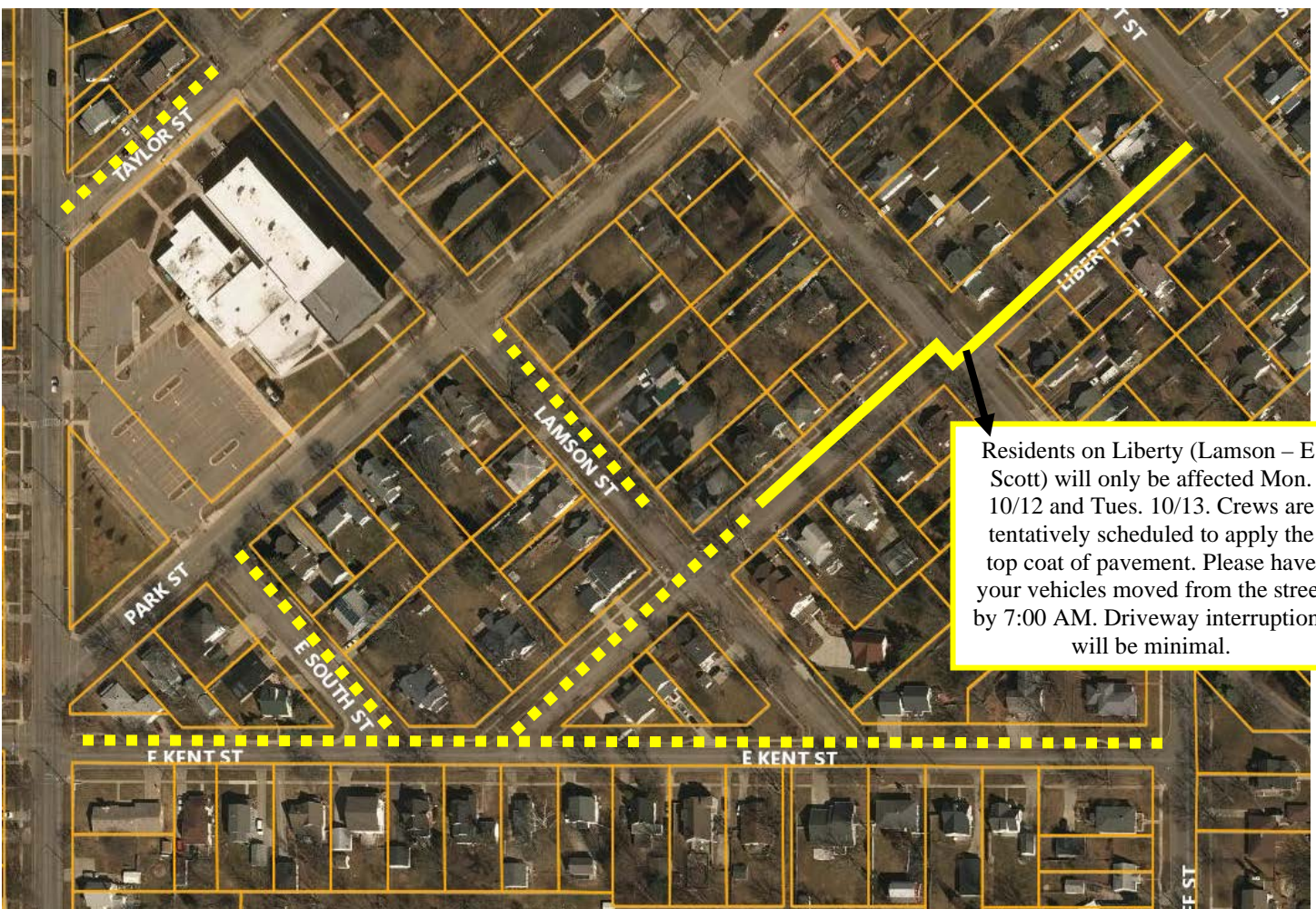

**NOTICE OF
DRIVEWAY ACCESS
INTERRUPTION
Sat. 10/10 – Tue. 10/13**



On Saturday, October 10, 2020, the street paving process is tentatively scheduled to begin in the area indicated on the map. During the paving process **Sat. October 10 – Tue. October 13, the noted section will be closed to ALL traffic for periods of time.** Residents in the noted section will experience driveway interruptions. *Please use caution while navigating this area!*

Why aren't vehicles allowed in the area? During the grading and paving process it is imperative that the ground surface remain unimpacted by vehicle traffic to prevent future damage to the street or unexpected emergencies.

PAVING ACTIVITY	DATE	IMPACT
PREPARATION	SAT. 10/10	Crews will be removing the gravel approach to each driveway in the indicated area. Driveways will be inaccessible (arriving and leaving) as the curb will be impassible. Please plan ahead and move your vehicles before 7:00 AM from your driveway. Any vehicle on your property after 7:00 AM cannot be moved until Tue. 10/13, or when paving is complete and traffic is allowed on the road.
	SAT. 10/10 – SUN. 10/11	Driveways remain inaccessible, but residents will be able to park on the street outside their homes. Overnight, on-street parking is permitted in Grand Ledge at this time.
BASE COURSE PAVING	MON. 10/12	Please move your vehicles off the street by 7:00 AM (do not move vehicles to another street in the paving area). Crews will begin the paving the base course. Street and driveway access will resume Tue. 10/13 or when paving is complete.
Please note, paving is done in three stages (base, second, and final course). Residents will be notified as each stage will interrupt driveway and street access temporarily.		

Why is the schedule 'tentative'? Weather conditions, especially rain, can impact the start and/or completion of a street resurfacing project. The City will provide updates via www.cityofgrandledge.com and residents can also call the Public Services Department, Monday – Friday between 8:00am – 5:00pm at 517-627-2144. The City advises all pedestrians and vehicles to use caution while navigating around construction.
