**Estimated Investment:** \$227,866

**Construction Year:** 2017-18

**Project Summary:** Replacement of failed Sandstone Creek culvert under W. South Street near Beagle Elementary School



## Water Tower Renovation

**Estimated Investment:** \$305,000

**Construction Year:** 2018

**Project Summary:** The 500,000-gallon elevated storage tank was renovated to extend the operational life of this critical infrastructure piece

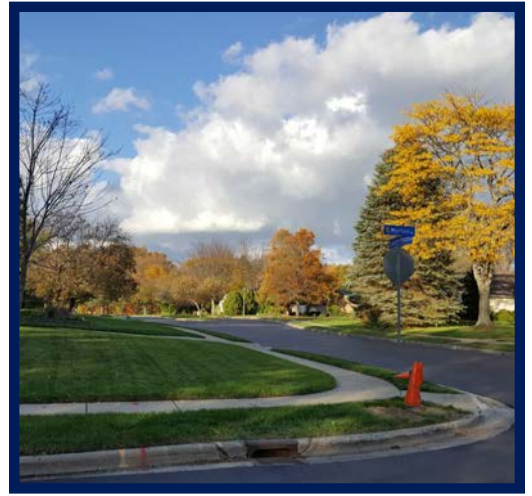


## Ledge Moor/Old Post

**Estimated Investment:** \$286,500

**Construction Year:** 2017

**Project Summary:** Street reconstruction and water main replacement



## Green Street

**Estimated Investment:** \$185,116

**Construction Year:** 2018

**Project Summary:** Street reconstruction and water main replacement



## Jenne Street Phases I & II (Phase III in 2020)

**Estimated Investment:** \$1,099,500

**Construction Year:** 2017

**Project Summary:** Street reconstruction and water main replacement



## E. River St./Russell St./Franklin St.

**Estimated Investment:** \$586,705

**Construction Year:** 2016

**Project Summary:** Street reconstruction and water main replacement, adding 101 parking spaces along East River Street.



## Jones Street

**Estimated Investment:** \$1,034,000

**Construction Year:** 2017

**Project Summary:** Street reconstruction and water main replacement



## Morley Street

**Estimated Investment:** \$500,000

**Construction Year:** 2019

**Project Summary:** Street reconstruction, water main and sidewalk replacement to improve Oakwood Cemetery, staging area for community parades, and spur economic development.



## Water Meter Change Outs

**Estimated Investment:** \$497,000

**Construction Year:** 2015 to present

**Project Summary:** By 2021, all business and residential water service customers will have new radio-read meters installed for more accurate water tracking and efficient reading. To date, 1,800, approx. 49%, of all meters have been upgraded.



## Airport Runway

**Estimated Investment:** \$1,600,000 (90% Federal/5% State of MI/5% City of Grand Ledge)

**Construction Year:** 2019

**Project Summary:** Reconstruction and paving of 3,200-foot of asphalt runway, upgraded LED light system, and new wind cone and direction indicators



## SAW Grant

**Grant Amount:** \$668,157

**Construction Year:** 2015-2018

**Project Summary:** Assessed condition of numerous wastewater lines by televising and capturing inventory and converted data into usable base plans in Geographic Information System (GIS).



## Fitzgerald Water Main Replacement

**Estimated Investment:** \$65,320

**Construction Year:** 2018

**Project Summary:** Replace water main within Fitzgerald Park



## C Drive Extension

**Estimated Investment:** \$139,501

**Construction Year:** 2017

**Project Summary:** Expansion of C Drive in the Industrial Park to accommodate expansion of Capitol Bedding and encourage additional economic development.
